

YM Camp 2024 Trip Packing List

Note: Personal gear must be in a waterproof pack. To do this, it is recommended that you condense your items into as few bags as possible. Items such as clothing, sleeping bags, scriptures, etc. should be stuffed into waterproof bags, garbage bags, or zip-locks. We will then put everyone's gear into heavy duty, extra-large contractor garbage bags that will be securely zip-tied each day. If any of your bags rip or get holes during the trip, notify a leader and they will supply replacements.

Recommended Personal Items

- Underwear x5
- Socks x5
- Quick dry lightweight pants or shorts
- T-shirts - x3
- Long sleeved shirt
- Long pant
- Something warm for evenings (light jacket or sweatshirt)
- Rain gear/Pancho (rain jacket can double as a jacket for warmth)
- Swimsuit
- Hat
- Water shoes or old shoes that can get wet
- Shoes for camp/hiking
- Travel home clothing (not to be worn until the trip home, kept in a separate bag)
- Mess kit, or bowl, plate, cup, utensils
- Waterproof bags or 5-gal bucket with sealed lid (see note above)
- Scriptures
- Water bottle (1.5 liters or larger)
- Flashlight and or headlamp with spare batteries
- Small or packable towel
- Bathroom kit (soap, toothbrush and paste, deodorant, toilet paper, hand sanitizer, etc.)
- Sunscreen
- Bug repellent
- Whistle
- Sleeping pad or mat
- Sleeping bag, 50-32F recommended

Optional Personal Items

- Personal first aid kit (including prescriptions) - there will be a group first aid kit which will carry the essentials
- Sunglasses with strap
- Lifejacket (one will be provided, but if you have one, it may be more comfortable)
- Paddling Gloves
- Rope (small paracord will be sufficient)
- Pillow

- Camera / phone (phone use is recommended to be limited to take the opportunity to unplug and be present with the experience; however, we encourage picture and video capture throughout the trip that we will have the opportunity to share with each other afterwards)
- Battery pack for recharging
- Personal snacks (note that there are black bears in the area, so no food should be stored inside the tents)
- Fishing equipment (make sure you understand regulations - much of the river is fly only)
- Fishing license (17 years old or older)

Quorum / Group Items

(Contact Advisors if you have these items available and are willing to send them to camp).

- Stove(s)
- Fuel
- Pots / pans, cooking utensils (as needed per menu)
- Fire starting materials
- Hatchet
- Easy up shelters
- Cooler for ice
- Water Jug
- Group first aid kit
- Tents
